## 4.02 RULES OF THE ROAD

- (1) All Vehicles which term as used herein, shall include among others: bicycles, automobiles, motorcycles and other motor vehicles, shall keep to the right of the center of the street.
  - (2) Vehicles meeting shall pass each other to the right.
  - (3) Vehicles overtaking others shall, in passing, keep to the left.
- (4) Vehicles at street intersections, turning into another street to the right, shall turn the corner as near to the right curb as possible.
- (5) Vehicles at Street intersections, turning into another street to the left, shall continue to the opposite side of the lateral street before changing the direction to the left.
- (6) Vehicles shall at all times keep the right side to the curb, if desiring to stop at the left side of the street, turn at the next intersection, bringing the right side of the vehicle to the curb.
- (7) When two vehicles approach an intersection of the Streets, from opposite directions, and desiring to turn in the same direction the right of way shall be given the vehicle making the shorter turn.
- (8) No Vehicles shall stop within an intersection or upon a cross walk except in case of an emergency or when directed to do so by the Police.
- (9) No vehicles shall remain backed up to the curb except when actually loading or unloading.
- (10) The apparatus and Vehicles of Fire, Police, United States mail departments and all ambulances, pub. or private, when sounding gongs, shall have the right of way through all streets and alleys. Vehicles in a funeral procession shall have the right of way over all vehicles, except the above named.
- (11) Any or all vehicles are forbidden to pass into or upon any street or alley of this Village that is barricaded by reason of improvement thereon or for any other cause.
- (12) No person, firm or corporation shall, by reason of loose boxes or overloading, in hauling crushed stone, cinders, dirt or any other material, drop or scatter any part of such load on any part of any Street or Alley of this Village.

- (13) Drivers of such vehicles are forbidden to sound their horns, bells, whistles, or gongs except as a warning signal. Automobile drivers or motorcyclists shall also be prohibited from using their muffler cutout on any of the streets of the Village except where they go up a sharp incline.
- (14) No person under the age of sixteen years, unless accompanied by parent, guardian or other adult person, shall operate, ride or drive any automobile, motorcycle or other similar motor vehicle along or upon any public highway of this Village.
- (15) No intoxicated person shall operate, ride or drive any automobile, motorcycle or other similar motor vehicle along or upon any public Highway of the Village of Hilbert.
- (16) The members of the Calumet County Police Department shall have the power and it shall be their duty to enforce and compel observance of the regulation provided by this Ordinance in the management of traffic upon the Public Streets and public places of the Village of Hilbert.
- (17) All Ordinances or parts of ordinances, resolutions or proceedings in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
