

4.05 SNOWMOBILES

(1) Except as otherwise specifically provided in this code, the statutory provisions in Chapter 350 of the Wisconsin Statutes, describing and defining regulations with respect to snowmobiles, exclusive of any therein relating to penalties to be imposed and exclusive of any regulations for which the statutory penalty is a fine or a term of imprisonment are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this code as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this code. Any future amendments, revisions, or modifications of the statutes incorporated herein are intended to be made part of this code.

(2) The plan for placement of snowmobile routes presented by the Hilbert Chapter of Calumet Sno-Trials, Inc. to the Village Board at its regular board meeting of August 14, 2001 is approved (see attached plan map). The Hilbert Chapter of Calumet Sno-Trails, Inc. is granted the authority necessary to implement said plan.

(3) Existing traffic control signs will be utilized wherever possible and that any necessary additional snowmobile route signs may be attached to existing street sign posts upon the approval of the Village.

(4) The attached plan map, which identifies the location of the route(s), is hereby considered a legal part of this ordinance and approval of the ordinance shall constitute approval of the plan as submitted.

(5) There shall be no property damage or personal injury liability on the part of either the Village or the snowmobile club.

(6) The Hilbert Chapter of Calumet Sno-Trails, Inc. agrees to be responsible for the general supervision of the route(s) and the maintenance of any necessary special route signing.

(7) Operators of snowmobiles are allowed to use the public streets to the most direct route to gain access to the trail. All operators must stay off private property and sidewalks and travel no more than ten miles per hour and must obey all existing street traffic signs and signals.

(8) Penalties for violation of this ordinance shall be as follows:

First Offense - \$50.00 fine plus court costs and fees
Second Offense - \$100.00 fine plus court costs and fees
Third & Subsequent Offenses - \$150.00 fine plus court costs and fees.
