

7.015 NON-ALCOHOLIC EVENTS: UNDER AGED PERSONS ON LICENSED PREMISES. An under aged person who is not accompanied by a parent, legal guardian, or spouse who has attained the legal drinking age may enter and remain on a Class "B" or "Class B" licensed premises only under the following conditions:

(1) No alcohol beverages including non-alcoholic beer, wine coolers, and other similar imitation type beverages, are consumed, sold, furnished, given away on, or carried into the licensed premises during the hours specified in the written authorization issued by the Calumet County Sheriff's Department.

(2) No persons under the age of 16 years old will be allowed on the premises unless accompanied by a parent, legal guardian, or spouse.

(3) During the period of any non-alcoholic event, all alcohol beverages, not stored in a locked portion of the licensed premises shall be stored in a secure place out of the sight and physical reach of any patron present and shall be under the direct and immediate control and supervision of the licensee, agent or licensed operator in the employ of the licensee or agent. All beer taps and automatic dispensers of alcohol beverages shall be disconnected, disassembled, or made inoperable.

(4) The licensee, the agent named in the license if the licensee is a corporation or a person who has an operator's license shall be on the premises at all times during the non-alcoholic event.

(5) The licensee has obtained written authorization, as required under the Wisconsin Statutes, from the Calumet County Sheriff's Department at least seven (7) calendar days in advance of the non-alcoholic event. A separate written authorization shall be obtained for each date a non-alcoholic event will be held.

(6) The licensee has notified the Village Clerk at least seven (7) calendar days in advance of the non-alcoholic event.

(7) During the period of any non-alcoholic event, a notice card issued by the Sheriff's Department shall be posted at all public entrances to the licensed premises notifying the general public that no alcohol beverages may be consumed, sold, furnished, or given away on, or carried into the licensed premises during the event. If for any reason the Sheriff's Department does not provide a notice card, the licensee shall be responsible for conspicuously posting the notice described in the preceding sentence.

(8) Closing hours established by appropriate State Statutes and Village Ordinance for such licensed premises shall be observed.

(9) Penalty for violation of this Ordinance shall be controlled by Ordinance No. 15.01.
