## FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD--

Highlights of the March Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- \*Resolution 2015-02 Opposing the County Assessment Proposal in the State Budget Bill.
- \*Ordinance 2015\_02 which amends Section 9.01(4)(a)(8)(b)(3) of the Code of Ordinances. It increases the maximum size of an accessory structure from 200 square feet to 500 square feet.
- \*To rezone property on Highway 114 west of 12th St. from Single Family Residential (R-1) to Industrial (I).
- \*The appointment of Michael Loose as fire chief of the Hilbert Volunteer Fire Department.
- \*Operator license for Kerry Herriot.
- \*Approval for Charlie Fochs and Josh McDonald to attend the WRWA Annual Conference in Green Bay at a cost of \$170 each.

The village board received notification of the following:

- \*Annual Spring Clean pickup will be on May 2<sup>nd</sup> from 8 a.m. 11 a.m.
- \*The next regular board meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 21, 2015. It is the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday due to the elections held on April 7<sup>th</sup>.
