FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD--Highlights of the March Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- *The request for Dennis DuPrey to attend the annual spring WI Treasurer's Association Conference in April.
- *The request for Charlie Fochs and Josh McDonald to attend the WRWA annual conference.
- *The request for Jeremy Baumgart to attend water certification schooling and take the certification test.
- *The request from Hilbert Revitalization Group to hold the annual Cheesehead Run on August 20, 2016 and block off Main Street.
- *Payment request for bills for WWTP upgrade in the amount of \$585,085.63.
- *Renewal of agreement to allow high school baseball/softball practices and games to be played at the Hilbert ball fields.
- *To participate in Wisconsin Deferred Compensation Program. There are no costs to the village.

The village received notice of the following:

- *Taxes collected to 1-31-16. Total taxes collected are down slightly but so is the percent of delinquencies.
- *A letter from the WI DOT stating that they are not approving the request to lower the speed limit on the north side of the village.
