## PROGRAM UPDATE

With the holiday season upon us, please keep in mind the banned items for landfills. One of the most common items that are replaced this time of year is electronics. With the current landfill ban, they are not allowed to be disposed with your regular garbage. There are several local businesses that will take electronics. Some of the businesses do charge a fee for disposing of the electronics which is never popular, but it is a far better option for the environment than it is to dispose these items. There are also avenues for donating your used cell phones so that they can be handed out to individuals who use them to call 911 when needed. Most cell phone retail outlets will take your old cell phones for this program. There will also be programs sponsored by the county for you to properly dispose of your electronics and hazardous materials. These are listed on the same page as the garbage and recycling pick up dates.

The Village is again picking up real Christmas trees after the holiday season to be recycled. The trees must be placed by the curb and all decorations, wires, bows, lights, etc. must be removed. If these guidelines are not followed, your tree will not be picked up. The deadline for picking up the trees will be <a href="Monday, January 16, 2023">Monday, January 16, 2023</a>. No trees will be picked up after this time. The village employees will make every effort to pick up the trees in a timely manner but we are at the mercy of Mother Nature. We will not pick up Christmas Wreaths. Because of the wires on them, we cannot chip them. Please dispose of them with your regular garbage. Any wreaths placed out on the curb will not be picked up.

### COMPOST SITE

We ask that you continually take care of disposing compost material properly. There are signs at the site that instruct you which pile is the proper location to dump your compost material and brush. We accept brush up to 4" in diameter. If there is a need to have the brush picked up (this is for larger quantities only), we ask that you contact the clerk's office to get on the list. We also ask that you remove all root balls from the brush and bushes. We cannot run those through the chipper.

# SPRING CLEAN AND TIRE RECYCLING

There will be a Spring Clean event again this next year along with a tentative tire recycling event. Please watch for the March newsletter which will give more details on these events along with our Facebook page and our website.

## STAFF/VILLAGE BOARD CHANGES

We have had several recent changes in our Village Board and staff. Jim Schmidt resigned as Village President in October because he moved outside the Village. James Schrubbe was appointed to fill out the unexpired term of the Village President. Joshua Krueger was appointed to fill out the unexpired Village Trustee term previously held by James Schrubbe. We also hired a new public works employee, Joel Thorpe from the Brillion area who started about 3 weeks ago. We also hired a part-time weekend employee that will assist with weekend duties. This will actually save the village on overtime hours. We have also hired a new Administrator Clerk Treasurer, Beth Nicklaus from the Chilton area who started November 28<sup>th</sup> and will train under me until my final date of employment on January 20<sup>th</sup>. If you see any of these new individuals, please welcome them to our community. For the first time in several months, we are now fully staffed.
