FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD -

Highlights of the June Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- Temporary Class B License to St. Mary's Congregation for the Annual Cheese Derby.
- To rezone 3 acres west of 12th St. on Highway 114 from R-1, Single Family Residential to I, Industrial.
- Approved the liquor, beer, soda and cigarette licenses for the upcoming licensing period of 7/1/19 to 6/30/20.
- To compensate the first responders \$10 per Wisconsin Ambulance Run Data System (WARDS) Report completed. This report is required for each call and takes approximately 15 minutes to one half hour to complete.
- Resolution 2019-05 to submit the treatment plant's Compliance Maintenance Annual Report. The plant received a GPA of 3.68 on a scale of 4.
- To send Dennis to the Annual Clerk's Convention to be held in Middleton WI from August 21st August 23rd.
- To approve the Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement with Calumet County to purchase a new voting machine that will be placed in service in time for the 2020 elections.

The village received notice of the following:

- Notice of receipt of the Cable TV Franchise Fees in the amount of \$2,252.00.
- Notice from the Wisconsin DOT that the project to mill and overlay pavement on Highway 114 from Highway 55 south of the Village of Sherwood to Highway 57/32 is moving forward this year. They will also be doing work on the culverts which will cause some temporary closing for a couple of weeks but otherwise the road should remain open during this project. We do not have an exact start date as of right now but the work has been authorized and should be completed sometime this summer.
- Received a notice from the Department of Natural Resources approving the Well #4 Facilities Plan and Specifications to install an iron removal filter system at the well.

BRUSH PICK-UP

Brush pick-up is available. If you have brush that needs to be chipped, you can either haul it to the compost site and place it on the brush pile or we can chip on site for larger quantities. We usually chip once a week on Wednesdays. We will chip brush up to 4" in diameter. You must contact the clerk's office at (920)853-3241 to request the chipping at your property. If you do not call to have the brush picked up and chipped, it will not be done.
