PROGRAM UPDATE

With the holiday season upon us, please keep in mind the banned items for landfills. One of the most common items this time of the year is electronics. There are some businesses that will dispose of them for you, but they usually charge a fee. There will also be programs sponsored by the county for you to drop off your electronics and hazardous materials. These are listed on the same page as the garbage and recycling pick-up dates.

CHRISTMAS TREE PICK-UP

The Village is again picking up real Christmas trees after the holiday season to be recycled. The trees must be placed by the curb and all decorations, wires, bows, lights, etc. must be removed. If these guidelines are not followed, your tree will not be picked up. We will not pick up Christmas wreaths, because of the wires in them they cannot be chipped.

COMPOST SITE

When using the compost site, please remember to read the signs and dump the compost material and/or brush on the proper piles. There are signs at the site that instruct you which pile is the proper location. We accept brush up to 4" in diameter. We also ask that you remove all root balls from the brush and bushes since they cannot be run through the chipper.

SPRING CLEAN EVENT
