#### The Village Board approved the following:

- To purchase a used DO/ORB probe for the WWTP in the amount of \$996.00.
- To replace the scum & drain pump at the WWTP in the amount of \$3,560.00.
- To purchase a new pick-up truck in the amount of \$28,840.00.
- To set a public hearing in regards to the request of Jeff & Lyn Wiese to rezone property from Industrial to R-1, Single Family Residential for April 20, 2021 at 7 p.m.
- The request for permission to hold the Cheesehead Run on August 14, 2021.
- The request to plant a memorial tree in memory of John "Jack" Mattes at Railroad Park.
- To amend the hauler rates effective May 1, 2021.
- To post the old jetter and air compressor for sale on the Government Surplus website.
- To allow Village employees to use the new jetter in emergency situations to help assist area municipalities when needed at no charge.
