Highlights of the November Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- *Change Order #4 for the treatment plant upgrade project for an additional \$18,784.87 of work at the plant.
- *Payment request for submitted bills through 11/10/15 in the amount of \$392,569.26 for the treatment plant upgrade.
- *To appoint Dan Starfeld as alternate Emergency Government Director.
- *The 2016 Budget for all funds. The overall tax rate for the village will be \$7.3098799 which is an increase of \$0.5606158 compared to last year. Copies are available by contacting the clerk's office.
- *Award the bid for the sale of the Chevy Kodiak Dump Truck to Greg Hackbarth for \$5,000.
- *To renew our insurance for 2016 with the League of Wisconsin Municipalities Mutual Insurance Company.
- *The conceptual plan for the Sargento Foods expansion.

The village board received notification of the following:

- *Notice of receipt of the quarterly Cable TV Franchise Fees in the amount of \$2,318.76.
- *Notice of final 1/1/15 population estimate for the village of 1,171 residents.
