From the Village Board – Highlights from the Regular Board Meeting:

**The Village Board approved the following:**

Resolution 2023-09 to set New Sewer Rates effective January 1, 2024. An increase of 5%. A current volume charge/1,000 gallons will increase from \$7.02 to \$7.37.

Resolution 2023-10 to set New Water Rates effective January 1, 2024. An increase of 8%. A current volume charge/1,000 gallons will increase from \$3.07 to \$3.32.

Operator's license to Andrea Thomas.

The Temporary Class B License for the Hilber-Potter Optimist Club for the Bingo Bash.

The purchase of a new sludge dewatering press in the amount of \$600,000.

The 2024 Budget for All Funds, the 2024 Levy Limit, the Local Tax Rate and all other Village Fund Budgets.

Lowering the prices of the current lots for sale in Village Meadows by \$2,500 and giving the Village President and the Administrator Clerk Treasurer room to negotiate the sales.

Annual garbage can fee increase from \$125 to \$140 per can; recycling can fee stays at \$25 per can.

The annual contract with Onward Accounting & Consulting, LLC for 2024.

The 2024 Police Contract with the Calumet County Sheriff's Department.
