RECYCLING NEWS UPDATE

PROGRAM UPDATE

As we proceed to the end of the year, our hope is that the dust has finally settled with the transition of moving to a new garbage/recycling contractor. Everyone should have been provided new containers by now. If you still do not have your new containers, please contact the clerk's office. If you still have old containers that need to be picked up, please contact the clerk's office. The old containers must be completely empty in order for them to be picked up. We have received a lot of positive feedback regarding the bi-weekly recycling. The Village was able to switch to this new recycling program without any rate increase. One of the major positives with this change to GFL is the Village's ability to have local customer service contact because we are dealing with their regional facility in Chilton again.

With the holiday season upon us, please keep in mind the banned items for landfills. One of the most common items that are replaced this time of year is electronics. With the current landfill ban, they are not allowed to be disposed with your regular garbage. There are several local businesses that will take electronics. Some of the businesses do charge a fee for disposing of the electronics which is never popular, but it is a far better option for the environment than it is to dispose these items. There are also avenues for donating your used cell phones so that they can be handed out to individuals who use them to call 911 when needed. Most cell phone retail outlets will take your old cell phones for this program. There will also be programs sponsored by the county for you to properly dispose of your electronics and hazardous materials. These are listed on the same page as the garbage and recycling pick up dates.

The Village is again picking up real Christmas trees after the holiday season to be recycled. The trees must be placed by the curb and all decorations, wires, bows, lights, etc. must be removed. If these guidelines are not followed, your tree will not be picked up. The deadline for picking up the trees will be **Monday**, **January 17**, **2022**. No trees will be picked up after this time. The village employees will make every effort to pick up the trees in a timely manner but we are at the mercy of Mother Nature. We will not pick up Christmas Wreaths. Because of the wires on them, we cannot chip them. Please dispose of them with your regular garbage. Any wreaths placed out on the curb will not be picked up.

If you have a damaged garbage or recycling container or wish to make changes, please contact the clerk's office. Do not contact the hauler directly.

COMPOST SITE

We ask that you continually take care of disposing compost material properly. There are signs at the site that instruct you which pile is the proper location to dump your compost material and brush. We accept brush up to 4" in diameter. If there is a need to have the brush picked up (this is for larger quantities only), we ask that you contact the clerk's office to get on the list. We also ask that you remove all root balls from the brush and bushes. We cannot run those through the chipper.

SPRING CLEAN AND TIRE RECYCLING

There will be a Spring Clean event again this next year along with a tire recycling event. Dates for these events have not been finalized as of yet. Please watch for the March newsletter which will give more details on these events along with our facbook page and our website.
