From the Village Board – Highlights from the Regular Board Meeting:

The Village Board approved the following:

- Liquor, beer, soda and cigarette licenses for the upcoming licensing period of 7/1/23 to 6/30/24.
- Application for Temporary Class B License for the Hilbert Lions Club for the 4th of July Picnic.
- Operator's license for: Kaitlyn Kresal, Samantha Lawrenz, Rebecca Wollersheim, Olivia Kaczorowski and Kaedanse Rothe.
- The employee health insurance renewal plan.
- Payment Request #3 to Feaker & Sons in the amount of \$21,351.40; Utility & Street Construction in Village Meadows 1st Addition.
- The contract and donation to the Eastshore Humane Society which provides the Village with a place to bring found dogs when the owners cannot be immediately identified.
- The reimbursement of the Civic Park flowers as requested by a resident.

The Village Board received notice of the following:

- The Recycling Grant in the amount of \$8,391.12.
- The Quarterly Franchise Payment in the amount of \$1,834.97.
- The Safe Drinking Water Loan Program – Final Project Closeout Notification.

Did you know that there are apartments available for seniors 55 years of age or older right here in Hilbert? It's the newly renovated 12 apartment building located at 135 S. 3rd Street. (It once was Sunrise Apartments and affiliated with the HUD Program). Now it's under new ownership/management and offers so many amenities to seniors. There are single and double

occupancies available and housekeeping, continental breakfast and access to community room spaces are included. There are also optional add-ons that can be set up for an additional monthly charge.
