FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD--Highlights of the June Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- *To allow fire department members to assist with a NASCAR race at Road America in Elkhart Lake and use their gear there.
- *To allow the fire department to begin looking at options for replacing Truck #33, the equipment truck.
- *To make repairs to the gazebo and stain it, put a copper top roof and a weathervane. This is being done with all donated material and the scouts will be doing the staining.
- *To paint the trim on the park buildings a dark blue with the paint that was donated.
- *Licenses for the upcoming licensing year.
- *Operator license for Natasha Grenzer.
- *Temporary Class B License to Hilbert Lions Club for the 4th of July Community Picnic & Fireworks
- *Resolution 2014-03 Declaring intent to reimburse expenditures for the Interceptor Main Replacement Project.
- *Resolution 2014-04 Appointing Authorized Representatives for the Interceptor Main Replacement Project.

The village board received notification of the following:

- *The 2013 Audit Report was presented. The report showed that the village is in strong financial shape and has adequate fund balance available in the event of lost aid as long as it is not continually raided.
- *Report on the Annual Board of Review. It showed an overall increase of \$273,440 or .58%.
- *Reports on classes attended by village personnel.
