FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD—
Highlights of the December Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- Operator's license for Saraswati Sharma.
- 2018 Lease Agreements for the Welcome to Hilbert Signs.
- Appointment of Andy King as the village's attorney for 2018.
- Resolution 2017_9 regarding the special assessments for the Highway 114 urbanization project.
- Resolution 2017_10 declaring public depositories for 2018.
- Resolution 2017_11 to place funds budgeted for 2017 that will not be expensed before year end to respective reserve funds.
- The village insurance renewal for 2018.
- Payment request in the amount of \$6,528.20 to MCC, Inc for the 2017 paving projects.
- To hire Cedar Corporation as the consultant for the Village Wide Development Plan.
- The recommendation to rent the village's 50 acres of land on the southside of the village to Schneider Farms for 2018.
- The revision of the employee handbook pertaining to schooling/training and sick days.
- Approved an incentive pay scale for full-time public works employees.

The village received notice of the following:

- Notice of the receipt of the 2nd installment of shared revenue in the amount of \$333,685,13.
- Notice of current year lottery credit in the amount of \$149.17.
- Notice of current year first dollar credit in the amount of \$85.24.
- Notice of current year state school tax credit in the amount of \$119,793.86 and estimated aid of \$1,239,714.00.
- Notice of receipt of the quarterly cable tv franchise fees in the amount of \$2,301,16.
