From the Village Board – Highlights from the Regular Board Meeting:

The Village Board approved the following:

- To purchase the culvert for the future trail system not to exceed \$3,000.
- To submit the DNR Safe Drinking Water Loan Program application.
- To accept the amendment to the offer to purchase in regards to the Sunrise Apartment buildings and to authorize DuPrey to do the prepayment of the loans on the properties.
- To hire Robert E. Lee to do plans and specs for the park bathroom with the guidelines determined by the Board.
- The operator's license for Nawaraj Subedi.
- The classes for the public works department employees for the 2021 Outdoor Expo and the DO Measurement in Activated Sludge.
- The request from Tom Pitts and Amy Hills in regards to the variance to have 3 dogs at their residence.
- Summer hours for the public works department employees with the full-time on-call employee working 8-hour days (5 days a week) and the other two full-time employees working 9-hour days (4 days a week) and 4 hours on Fridays. This was approved on a one-year trial basis running from June 1st September 1st.
- The WWTP operator to have lunch at the plant instead of having to come to the Village Hall.

The Village received notice of the following:

- The Notice of Receipt of the Personal Property Tax Aid—Real Estate in the amount of \$3,060.47.
- The Notice of Receipt of the Personal Property Tax Aid—TIF Districts in the amount of \$4,807.93.
- The Condition of the Budget All Funds.
