FROM THE VILLAGE BOARD -

Highlights of the June Board Meeting:

The village board approved the following:

- The application for an operator's license for Corinna Maes, Christopher Leitner, Melissa McArdle and licenses for the upcoming licensing periods.
- Temporary Class B Picnic License for the Calumet Sno-Trails for their Annual Cheese Derby on June 14th.
- Temporary Class B Picnic License for the Hilbert Lions Club for their Annual 4th of July Community Picnic & Fireworks Celebration on July 4th.
- The request by Scotty's Bar & Grill to hold their annual anniversary party on July 3rd and block off Chestnut St. with the condition that they notify the neighbors prior to the event.
- The request by the Village Hearthstone to have multiple outdoor music events in 2018.
- The request by Charlie Fochs to purchase safety equipment in the amount of \$1,297.00; with \$500.00 coming from a grant.
- The request by Charlie Fochs to replace the dump box on the dump truck, purchase a new salt box and hoist and also have undercoating installed in the amount of \$24,947.00 as budgeted.
- The recommendation from the Park & Recreation Committee to purchase one new cooler for the park in the amount of \$2,226.00 as budgeted.
- Resolution 2018-1 "Village of Hilbert Resolution to Disallow Demand for Damages by Todd Thiel and 510 North 8th Street LLC".
- Resolution 2018-2 to submit the Annual CMAR report for the wastewater treatment plant.
- Resolution 2018-3 in Support of Nsight Teleservices' Application for a PSC Broadband Expansion Grant.
- To continue pursuing steps toward allowing ATV's and golf carts to operate within the village.
- The recommendation by the Park & Licensing Committee to keep the ordinance as is regarding chickens not being allowed in the village.
